- Have 2-4 founders or management level teammates work in iVenture full-time during the summer sprint based in a Research Park co-working space. A majority of your team members must be UIUC students. Non-UIUC students do not receive stipends.
- Have a majority of your team enroll in or audit a 3-credit hour iVenture Seminar course in Fall '17 and Spring '18. Offered as BADM395 and TE498.
- Be actively working on a venture creating either tech, social, commercial, or cultural value.

SELECTED iVENTURE EXPERIENCES:



Cast21 designed an innovative casting technology in a senior design course. They've since been admitted ZeroTo510 (#1 US med device accelerator) and raised \$800K for their seed round, and are working full-time on the venture.



During iVenture, Invoq Health wrote 200,000 lines of code and deployed tablet-based healthcare management software to 60 village healthcare workers serving 120,000 patients in India. They recently closed a contract to manage 500,000 more records at MP Birla Hospital in Satna, India.



After winning 1st place at the Cozad New Venture Competition, Amber Ag used the summer to conduct 50+ customer interviews and refine their business model. They continued product development at Hax Accelerator in Shenzhen, China, and were named "Best Startup" by Engadget at the 2017 CES Show,
